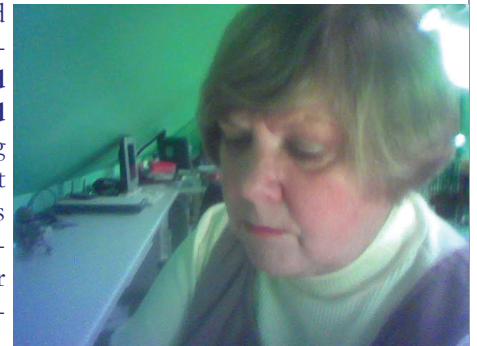
### PROFILE
